

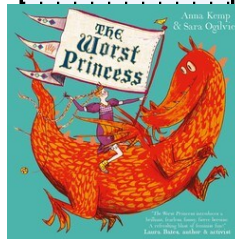
Maths

In Maths, the children will continue to consolidate their number recognition and counting skills. They will start to investigate number bonds to 10. They will also be exploring 3D shapes.



Science

In Science, the children will be investigating seasonal change and comparing different environments. They will be naming and sorting animals and finding out where they live.



PE

This term, the children will be doing Gymnastics during their PE sessions. Using some traditional tales as a stimulus for travelling, creating shapes and balancing.

PSHE

Our Jigsaw theme this half term is 'Healthy Me'. The children will be learning about making healthy food choices and the importance of exercise.



English

The children will be ordering stories and comparing the settings of the books that we will be reading.

They will continue to work on letter formation and the reading and writing of CVC words and 'tricky' words.

The children will be writing some simple sentences to describe characters.



History/Geography

The children will be finding out about the local area. They will also be comparing different countries in the world. They will be finding out about life in castles and creating a medieval banquet.

Music

Our theme for Music this half term is 'The world'. The children will continue to listen to and evaluate different styles of music and learn some new and songs. They will be also be using some percussion instruments.

RE

This half term, the children will be thinking about the question:

Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter garden?

They will be listening to the Easter story and learning about the sequence of Holy Week.

Art/DT

This half term, the children will be making cards, creating African patterns, silhouettes pictures and making decorations for our medieval banquet at the end of term.
