## What transport do we use?

### Maths

In maths we will begin the half term focussing on the place value of numbers within 50. We will then move on to measurement, learning how find out height and width. We will then look at mass and volume using the words full and empty.

### Science

#### Animals including humans (comparing animals)

This unit will begin this half term and then continue after the Easter break. We will identify animal groups and look at each group in turn to identify their unique features.

### PSHE

#### Healthy me

In this unit we will discuss how to lead a healthy lifestyle. We will explore hygiene, medicines and the importance of exercise.

### PE

PE will rotate between the following themes:

- Sending and receiving.
- Changing speeds. (dance)
- Controlling jumps and rolls within a sequence.
- Striking and fielding.

### Trip

We are very excited about our trip to 'Call of the Wild' this half term. This will support our learning in Science.

### English

#### Poetry - The puffin book of fantastic first poems

We will start the half term with a unit on poetry. We will identify rhyming words and then compose and write our own poetry.

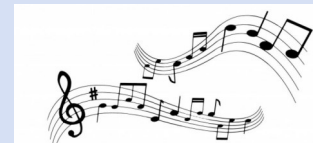
#### Pattan's Pumpkin—An Indian flood story

### Computing

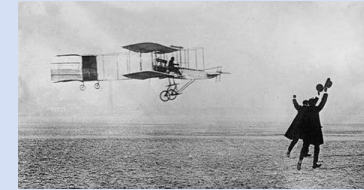
#### Programming
